

The Porterfields to South Sudan Prayer Letter September 2014 Update

Seeing God at work is so exciting! A lot has happened this month and we're so thankful to be a part of it. We have a couple more churches who have agreed to partner with us and a couple that we're waiting to receive support from, bringing our support to about 79%! Praise the Lord! We're also happy to announce that our Bible container is just days away from being shipped! We have finalized the details of where to store the container when it arrives so we can have easy access to it to start distributing God's Word to the people of Africa. Thank you to all of you who have prayed and given to make this goal a reality. Only heaven will tell of the difference you have made in the people's lives who will receive God's Word from this shipment.

Attention pastors and churches! As you know, our goal is to carry out the Great Commission, and we pray that is your goal too. To help you with a practical way to do that, Blind Faith Ministries would like you to consider starting a church from your church! Your church could travel to a country in Africa or South America, win souls to Christ, help acquire property, and even help a national pastor financially take care of his family while he shepherds the new church. We believe this process could revive the saints here and give them a renewed vision that God is still moving in a great way in the world. If your church wants to start a church by faith, and help to develop and nurture a group of believers, let us know! Just imagine how this method could spread the gospel if all of our churches got involved! You could do this as a project or pull it out of your missions budget monthly, trusting God to bring in the finances through the obedience of His people. This is a biblical mandate and pattern, and we just want to implement it and watch God work in these last days before He comes. Please consider starting a church from your church!

Things in our churches in South Sudan, Congo, and Uganda are still going well. We will send their prayer letters so you can read them for yourselves. Pardon the poor English, but we want you to see for yourselves how these men are watching God move in their life

Another prayer request has been answered...Brother Carlos Ramos from Venezuela will be landing on US soil on September 16. We are looking forward to him being here and hearing him share with the churches he visits about what God is doing in South America. Pray that the rest of his schedule will be filled, and that he will be able to raise the support he needs for his church planters in his short time here.

Please continue to remember our family in your prayers, and that our container would get shipped as planned. In closing, we would ask that you SINCERELY pray for the Long family. Their son, Jude, who will be 2 in November, has a tumor on his brain. This hits especially close to home for us with the birth of our daughter, and we can't imagine the heartache this family is facing. Specifically pray for little Jude's appetite to come back as the chemo has taken it. Also pray for the tumor to decrease in size and for finances for the family to pay for the treatments he needs. If these things don't come to pass, it could drastically shorten little Jude's time here on earth. Please take time to pray. We're so thankful to serve a God who knows our hurts and has the power to intervene. Keep on seeking Him.
