

The Porterfields to South Sudan Prayer Letter March/April 2015 Update

Happy Easter! We pray this season of celebration of our Savior's resurrection will encourage you to reach out to those around you and tell them what He has done for you! He has done so much for us!

Our monthly support has slightly increased to about 84%. We are thankful that God is still moving us forward... slowly but surely! We'd like to say a big "thank you" to the churches who have decided to partner with us recently!

Our hearts go out to the members of one of our supporting churches as they unexpectedly lost their pastor, Brother Russell Ellison. We'd ask that you please pray for this church and the family of Brother Ellison as they grieve this tremendous loss and try to press on for Jesus Christ.

Things are going well in the ministries in South Sudan, Uganda, Congo, and Venezuela. We have attached letters from these men, and as always, we have made a couple changes to make it somewhat more readable, but left the letters mostly in their original form so you can see for yourself how God is working in these men's lives.

Pray for the men working in South Sudan, as in addition to the victories, there have been various trials, such as people trying to work against us at the prison by using bribery, as well as the Anglican church trying use money to lure people away from our church. Money can be used for good, but in these cases, it is being used to hinder the Lord's work. Pray God will intervene.

This month, a supporting church in Michigan was able to take a trip to Venezuela to help start a church with Brother Carlos Ramos. They were also able to see scores of people saved through their evangelism and outreach efforts! What a blessing! Please let us know if your church would have any interest in doing something like this in the countries we work with. We have also received some funds for Carlos' van, praise the Lord! Just a little more is needed.

The Lord has given us a possible opportunity to work with Brother Botros from Egypt. You can view more information about his ministry at http://youtu.be/vODp2HifTt0. We are hoping to possibly support some of his nationals. Pray the Lord opens this door if this is what He would have us to do. Continue to pray about the opportunity that may be opening for us in Cuba as well.

On May 1-2, 2015, Blind Faith Ministries will be having a youth rally with the theme "Called to Duty" at Rich Creek Baptist, in Spanishburg WV. We want to emphasize the need for Christian education at this rally and want as many young people as we can get to attend. We already have around 20 churches committed to come.
