These past few weeks have been filled with ups and downs. As many of you know, we found out we were expecting another child! We were overjoyed, and couldn't wait to meet him or her! However, we recently found out that our baby is now with Jesus. While our hearts are heavy, we rejoice that because of Christ, one day we will get to meet him or her. Thank you for your prayers for our family during this tough time.

Our monthly support is still going upward, despite another church having to decrease support due to finances. We are now at 92% and heading down the final stretch of raising our personal support!

South Sudan has now been listed as the fourth most dangerous nation in the world due to all that has been going on there in recent days. Our heart breaks for the brethren there, as their families and loved ones continue to have to endure so much suffering. Please pray for them fervently and often. Our military ministry there will either be moving or we will lose it altogether as the military barracks have recently been sold to the Chinese. Pray for us as we seek to raise funds to put a Bible Institute in this war torn nation in 2016.

Please pray for our National Director in Uganda, Brother George Lambert, as the roof of his home recently collapsed, destroying his house and many of his belongings, including his library. We are so saddened for him. Pray the Lord will provide for his very basic needs in this hard time. The works there are going on well.

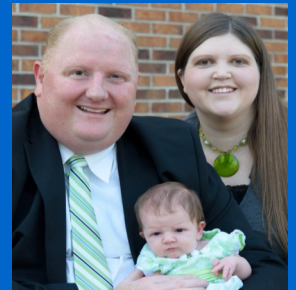
