Unrest is everywhere it seems, in America and worldwide. Unfortunately, this is true for our beloved South Sudan as well. Please be much in prayer for this country as there has been major fighting occurring in the capitol city of Juba. People are evacuating, hundreds more have been killed already, and the government is divided. All of this is IN ADDITION to a major humanitarian crisis, with millions on the verge of starvation. Please take time to pray for peace in this war torn country, for God to continue to save souls there, and for wisdom for us concerning how to best restructure our ministries to reach these souls for Christ.

We are already close to our goal financially for the Uganda Land project, praise the Lord! Thank you so much for praying...He has answered! We are still trying to raise funds for The South Sudan Building Project, The Uganda Building Project, and The Venezuela Building Project, so keep praying! God is at work!

The ministries in Venezuela are holding strong, but still in need of financial support. Continue to pray for this country as it is in turmoil economically. The Congo ministries are stable as well, and we are so thankful for that. Things in Cuba are going well. Pray for souls to be saved there specifically this month, as they will be doing a VBS-type outreach ministry there.

We'd also ask you to pray for our home state of WV. Massive flooding has devastated areas very close to our home, including one of our supporting churches. It is heartbreaking to see and hear the stories of people who have lost everything, many of which did not have insurance. The God Bless America rally that was to be held here has been cancelled, and all the funds that were raised for that project will be going to help flood victims. God is using this tragedy, heartwrenching as it is, to bring souls to Himself. He is so good.

Continue praying for the Lord to send us an assistant and a secretary. This is a major prayer request that we really need God to answer in order for our ministry to keep moving forward. Pray for doors to open in Egypt, as we feel the Lord wants our ministry to expand into this country as well. And please keep praying for my mother's back, as she recently had surgery to try to correct the issues she is having. Thank you for being our friends in Christ, and for showing your love to us through prayers and financial support. We love and are thankful for each of you.
