The Porterfields to South Sudan Prayer Letter May/June 2018 Update

We want to begin by praising the Lord for the increase we have seen in our ministries in the past few months! We have seen God do BIG things across the globe. We are so thankful for this! We are also excited as time draws closer to welcoming our baby boy into the world! We expect to meet him around the middle of June. Please continue to pray for Jessica and baby Johnny's health during the remainder of her pregnancy.

George has confirmed 31 works connected to our ministry in Africa. Taban James had a big day with over 21 people in Northern Uganda being saved. Many had been waiting for the baptismal service, and over 20 people were recently baptized. Praise the Lord for this!

Carlos Ramos had a big day of over 4,000 people in Venezuela. Please pray as we would like to expand the work there. Buildings are cheap due to the destabilizing crisis. Please continue to pray and give to these advances as the Lord leads you. Our work in Cuba is stable and solid. We do not have many converts there, but several people are consistently disciplined.

We have not been traveling heavy over the past several months, but I have taken several opportunities to preach in local churches in our area. All of our ministries are expanding and growing. Because of this we are looking to gain more support for future projects and for our nationals. Please be in prayer about this. We have some churches that are interested in supporting our nationals. This would be an answer to prayer and a blessing to our ministry. Please pray that these things continue.

We recently won the Republican primary for House of Delegates in District 27 here in Southern West Virginia. I will be representing the Republican Party in the fall election. We won a competitive election by 8 votes. We want to ensure all of our supporters that we did NOT and will not use ministry funds for campaigning. Legally and ethically we cannot and would not do this. This is a part-time legislative work. Due to the attacks against the First Amendment and religious liberty as well as the Second Amendment someone needed to do something, so we went forward praying that the Lord would use us. The story of our win is quite miraculous! Pray for us that if it is the Lord's Will for us to continue in this work that we would win the fall election, as well as continuing Blind Faith Ministries just as it has always been. We need support now more than ever. We have had a few churches that have dropped us because of my choice to stand in the gap on these issues, but we ask that you would consider increasing your support for us as well as for our nationals. If you are not financially involved in our ministry, we pray that you would consider supporting us and our works across the world. With 31 works in Africa, 8 in Venezuela, 1 in Brazil and Cuba, we have many works that require and need our support. The Lord is doing BIG things and it would be a blessing if you were involved in so great a work!

As always, we truly do appreciate your continued prayers for our family and ministry. We feel so blessed to be used by Him in this great work He has called us to. We love playing this small part in what the Lord is doing all around the world. Thank you for your support.
