We are very excited about what the Lord is doing through Blind Faith Ministries. It's a continual encouragement to us how the ministry continues to make progress despite Satan's attempts to stop it.

In early September, approximately 14 students will be getting their graduate certificate from our Bible institute in Uganda. Their faithfulness and commitment to accomplishing this goal has been a blessing both to me and our Ugandan leadership.
