It is with the highest recommendation that I would like to encourage you to consider Brother Eric Porterfield as a potential missionary for support. Brother Eric is a missionary to South Sudan, which is the newest nation in the world. He and his wife Jessica went on a 6 week missionary survey trip in June-July 2012. On their trip, they had the privilege of seeing over 3,000 people trust Christ as their Savior. Brother Eric preached in schools, prisons, orphanages, military barracks, and went door to door preaching the gospel. In addition to the decisions that were made, a church was planted and services were started in Juba, South Sudan. Please pray for their church as the nation is currently in civil conflict.

Brother Eric is a Fundamental, Independent Baptist missionary that holds to a biblical position on the Bible (KJV exclusively). He is distinctively Baptist, and holds to the same biblical positions as our church. A unique characteristic about Brother Eric is that he is a blind missionary and, as his testimony will reflect, God has used his blindness as much as anything to open this special door in South Sudan. He has also founded ASSIST (Assisting the Savior's Servants In Service and Training). This is a program to support national pastors and Christian workers. Through ASSIST, 7 additional churches have been started. They currently have 8 national pastors and church planters that they financially assist.
